



JOB OFFER: FULL-TIME POST-DOCTORAL POSITION European project (Horizon 2020) on policies and indicators towards a sustainable wellbeing economy

We are looking for a **post-doctoral researcher** with in-depth knowledge of the post-growth and beyond-GDP debates and policies and with specific skills in the identification, selection, processing, and management of wellbeing and/or sustainability indicators.

The researcher will contribute to a task carried out by ICHEC on wellbeing and sustainability indicators in the framework of the EU-funded "ToBe" project (Horizon 2020). The project is led by Tampere University (Finland) and includes several international partners. She/he will work under the supervision of task leader Prof. Philippe Roman (ICHEC Brussels Management School) and in collaboration with other ToBe partners.

Profile required:

- We welcome high-profile candidates (PhD or minimum 3-year research experience) with a background in economics, social sciences and/or statistics (the list is not restrictive), with a strong focus on social and environmental issues.
- Candidates should demonstrate an ability to critically appraise wellbeing and/or sustainability indicators and to understand the socio-political issues related to quantification.
- Previous involvement in an international research project and a high degree of autonomy in scientific work would be highly appreciated.
- Excellent writing, understanding, and speaking skills in English are required.
- Affinity for teamwork, adaptability and interpersonal skills are very much appreciated.

Conditions offered:

- The proposed contract is a **15-month** (from June 1, 2023 to August 31, 2024) **full-time position** as **post-doctoral researcher at ICHEC Brussels Management School**.
- The researcher will work in a stimulating working environment and participate in an interdisciplinary European research project.
